What is a Growth Group?

What is a Life Group?

Fellowship Groups focus on fellowship and activity. They enjoy creating environments for play, hobbies, and fellowship with other believers and use this to introduce others through common interests to Jesus.

Sundays | 6:00pm | Under the Hood: The Gospel of Mark | The Community Room | Led by Dr. Charles Armour

Dr. Armour will be going deeper with our series, *THE BEST NEWS EVER*. Each session will be self-contained so folks can still benefit even if they are unable to attend regularly. This will be an in-depth study geared at helping people gain a better and deeper understanding as well as an appreciation of this Gospel. Both the beginning and advanced Bible student will find things they can learn. We shall examine the language and meaning of the text in order to convey Mark's original intent and compare it to the other Gospel traditions. From that, we will ask the question; "What is God saying through this?" Additional writings may also be considered as they pertain to Mark, inclusive of early church fathers, Dead Sea Scrolls and Hellenistic literature. All of Mark will be taught from the perspective of it being "sacred and inspired literature", which we believe it certainly is.
