Jesus + Nothing = Everything

"Jesus + Nothing = Everything" is a phrase that encapsulates the central message of the Gospel according to the Christian faith. It reflects the essence of salvation, emphasizing that our relationship with Jesus Christ is the source of our identity, purpose, and fulfillment. In Galatians, Paul passionately argues against the necessity of circumcision and other Jewish rituals for salvation, asserting that they are not required for Gentile believers. He emphasizes the concept of

spiritual freedom in Christ and warns against returning to a life of bondage to the law. Paul is explaining to the church of Galatia the foundational principle that salvation is by grace alone, through faith in Christ alone, and not through works or adherence to religious rituals or laws. As Christians, we have to constantly preach the Gospel to ourselves. Satan wants Christians to minimize the work of the cross so that he can wreak havoc in our lives. Christians can often fall into this trap of legalism or work-based righteousness. However, Paul makes it very clear that salvation is faith alone in Christ. It is important for the oldest believer and the newest believer to remember Jesus + Nothing = Everything. This equation invites us to surrender our striving and self-reliance, recognizing that Jesus paid it all so that we may have eternal life.

Galatians 1:3-5

3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, **4** who gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, **5** to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen.
